Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)

Project Description

The Subrecipient for this project is the Community Resource Center (CRC) and the Harrisonburg Redevelopment & Housing Authority (HRHA). The CRC/HRHA will provide a Homeless Management Information System for the City of Harrisonburg. HMIS is a computerized data collection system designed to capture client-level information over time on the characteristics and service needs of men, women, and children experiencing homelessness. It is designed to aggregate client-level data and generate an unduplicated count of clients served within a community's system of homeless services. The CRC will provide the equipment, software, services staff for training and programming, personnel and office space. Computers and training are provided for each homeless program (primary shelters). Contacts from homeless families and individuals will initiate through the CRC and be referred to services as indicated by need and availability. The CRC/HRHA jointly requested \$6,000.
