TRAFFIC ALERT

June 30, 2010

The Harrisonburg Police Department reminds city-goers of upcoming street closures in preparation for the downtown Independence Day celebrations.

On July 3, several different streets will be closed throughout the day.

- 10 a.m. - Court Square will be closed to all traffic and will remain closed until approximately 11 p.m.
- 3 p.m. – the left lane of South Liberty Street will be temporarily closed to allow parade entries to line up
- 3 p.m. – Main Street, from Cantrell Avenue to Gay Street, will be closed
- 6 p.m. – after the parade is finished most streets will be reopened
- Main Street, from Franklin to Elizabeth streets, will stay closed after the parade until approximately 11 p.m.

Please be vigilant of these street closures and an increase in pedestrian traffic in the downtown area.

This is also a reminder that it is illegal to set off fireworks in the City of Harrisonburg.
