The following general statements shall apply to all permits:

- 1. Qualifying projects must be covered under a VSMP Stormwater Permit for Construction Sites. Applicant must sign VSMP certification statement below for qualifying projects and provide evidence of VSMP Permit acquisition.
2. All projects shall conform to the Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control Regulations, the Virginia Stormwater Management Regulations and the project's SWPPP, unless a variance has been granted in writing by this locality.
3. This permit must be kept on the work site and shown when requested.
4. The City Construction Inspector must be notified 48 hours before work begins. Periodic inspections will be made by City personnel during or immediately following initial installation of erosion and sediment controls, at least once in every two-week period, within 48 hours following any runoff producing storm event and at the completion of the project prior to the release of any bonds. If applicant desires to be informed before inspections, please contact City inspector assigned to project.
5. Other work (stripping, grading, excavating, construction) on the project shall not commence until the sediment controls are in place as specified on the plan.
6. Applicant agrees to maintain the work in the manner approved upon its completion and after any significant rainfall.
7. Applicant understands that an engineer's as-built certification statement is required for all stormwater management facilities, and agrees to coordinate with engineer as necessary to ensure needed inspections.

City of Harrisonburg's Erosion and Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Ordinances require a Bond or Surety to be posted in the amount determined by the Erosion and Sediment Control Administrator. Such Bond or Surety shall be conditioned to conform to any work to approve standards, specifications and criteria as set out in the Approved Plans.

Final Inspections of the project shall be made by the Program Authority. The release of Bonds and Sureties is contingent upon the findings of such inspections. Release of Surety will occur only after disturbed areas are deemed permanently stabilized by the ESC Administrator, all Stormwater management facilities are satisfactorily completed, and as-built certifications are provided.
