**Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:**

**CHAPTER 2. - SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL**

**ARTICLE E. - SOLID WASTE RECYCLING**

**Be amended as shown:**

**DIVISION 1. - SOLID WASTE RECYCLING REPORT**

**Sec. 6-2-73. - Annual report.**

- (a) *Report required.* All nonresidential solid waste generators and companies that manage solid waste or recycle materials generated within the city shall submit an annual report, if requested by the director, ~~of sanitation.~~

**~~DIVISION 2. - PURCHASE OF RECYCLED PAPER PRODUCTS~~ ~~DELETE AND RESERVE~~**

~~The purpose of this division is the promotion of governmental utilization of recycled paper and paper products as provided for in section 11-47.2 and section 15.1-11.5:01 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.~~


**~~Sec. 6-2-75. - Definitions of "recycled paper and paper products."~~**

~~"Recycled paper and paper products" means any paper and paper products meeting the EPA recommended content standards as defined in 40 CFR Part 250.~~

**~~Sec. 6-2-76. - Awarding of contracts:~~**


~~In determining the award of any contract for paper or paper products to be purchased for use by any division, department or agency of the city, the purchasing agent shall use competitive sealed bidding and shall award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder offering recycled paper or paper products of a quality suitable for the purpose intended, so long as the bid price is not more than ten (10) percent greater than the bid price of the low responsive and responsible bidder offering a product that does not qualify under this division.~~

This ordinance shall be effective from the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, 2021. Adopted and approved this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, 2021.
