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About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey[™], the City of Harrisonburg conducted a mailed survey of 1,200 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in January and February 2014 and data was collected through February 2014. After the official data collection period was over and the data were reported (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Harrisonburg, VA, 2014*), the City made available a Web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's Web site. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during March, April and May; 175 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the Web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of Harrisonburg.
