City and County to Hold Joint 9/11 Observation

Harrisonburg, VA — The City of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County are jointly remembering the events of September 11, 2001. This is in concordance with US Senate Resolution 237 which establishes a moment of remembrance at 1:00 PM EDT on September 11, 2011. This moment is to be marked with the sounding of bells and sirens and a cessation of work.

This event begins at 12:45 PM at the Veterans Memorial at James Madison University's Memorial Hall. There will be a singing of the national anthem and recognition of the flag prior to the one o'clock mark when sirens and bells will sound to mark the moment of remembrance. The event concludes with an invocation, speakers and the playing of taps.

The public is invited to join elected officials, the Harrisonburg Police and Fire Departments and the Rockingham County Sheriff's Office and Fire and Rescue at the memorial for this event.

In recognition of the day, the City of Harrisonburg will also be displaying the US flag along Main Street as is done for other national holidays.
