Input Sought on Ramblewood Fields Discussion Regarding Dog Park Also Planned

Harrisonburg, VA — At the October meeting of the City of Harrisonburg's Parks and Recreation Commission, the public will be encouraged to provide feedback on the future of Ramblewood Fields.

Ramblewood Fileds is a 60 acre park facility which has four softball diamonds and soccer fields. Much of the land in the parcel housing the current facilities is undeveloped and the Parks and Recreation Commission is seeking input on possible future uses.

"When a park has adjacent undeveloped space, it is a chance for us to take community feedback and try to incorporate some of what our end users most want to see in our recreation programs," said Director of Parks and Recreation, Lee Foerster. "Ideas for this space run the gamut of possibilities and we want to make sure that those people who will use the park get a chance to share their ideas."

The Parks and Recreation Commission meeting will be held on October 17th, 2011 at Stone Spring Elementary School. The meeting will begin at seven in the evening.

At the same meeting the commission expects to hear from the public regarding the possible addition of a dog park to the city's current recreation facilities.
