WESTOVER POOL CLOSED DUE TO FLOODING

Harrisonburg, VA – Westover Pool will be closed for repairs due to flood damage for the immediate future.

Due to heavy rains, portions of the Westover Pool Complex were flooded on the night of March 20. The flooding damaged mechanical equipment, including a heater, chlorine pump and filters. The equipment will be sent out for repair.

Additionally, a barrel of muriatic acid was over turned in the flooding. Muriatic acid is used to help maintain Ph balance in pool water. The Harrisonburg Fire Department responded and assessed that there was no danger from hazardous material.

“We are working to get the pool back into working order as fast as possible,” said Aquatics Director Kristin Lam. “The response of our staff and other city departments to mitigate damage and return us to normal has been great.”

The pool will reopen once all necessary repairs have been made. A notification of reopening will be sent to the media.
