Facilities at City Parks to Close for the Season

Harrisonburg, VA – This week the facilities at Harrisonburg parks will close for the season.

Starting Nov. 1, the electricity to all park bathrooms and shelters will be turned off for the winter season.

At 5 p.m. every evening, the gates at Westover Park and Hillendale Park will be locked.

All parks will still be accessible to the community; however, the restroom facilities and water fountains will not be operating.

Park facilities will reopen on April 15, 2013 with the exception of Riven Rock Park, which opens on May 15, 2013.

The Harrisonburg Parks and Recreation Department manages 10 parks, a playground, bike trails, soccer complex, softball and baseball fields, and two pools. The largest park in the City of Harrisonburg is Hillendale Park that encompasses 74 acres. More information about the parks can be found online at www.HarrisonburgVA.gov/parks-recreation.
