Parks and Recreation Provides Winter Fun

Harrisonburg, VA – Harrisonburg’s Parks and Recreation Department is providing residents with fun indoor activities to pass the time during the winter months.

The indoor swimming pool at Westover Park is open daily to the public and is currently running programs such as mommy and me swim classes, aqua aerobics, and swim lessons.

The indoor pool is kept at a temperature of 81 to 83 degrees, providing swimmers with a break from the cold weather. Admission to the pool is \$3 for city residents over the age of 18 and \$2 for city residents younger than 18. For non-city residents a day pass costs \$5 for adults and \$3 for children.

Beginning this year both pools at Westover Park have installed a handicap lift, making the pools ADA compliant.

Along with activities at Harrisonburg’s indoor pool, the Parks and Recreation Department hosts more than 30 programs on a weekly basis. These programs vary by interest and age group but range from group fitness classes to enrichment programs and more.

The Harrisonburg Parks and Recreation Department manages 10 parks, a playground, bike trails, soccer complex, softball and baseball fields, and two pools.
