Parks and Recreation Needs Input from Community

Harrisonburg, VA – The Harrisonburg Parks and Recreation Department is in need of feedback from the community.

In an effort to plan for the future of city park facilities and services, the Parks and Recreation Department is in the process of developing an update to its Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

“With new trends and desires of the community, we felt it was important to update our vision and long term plans,” said Lee Foerster, Director of Parks and Recreation.

The last study, to develop a master plan for Parks and Recreation, was completed in 2003 and is available online for the community to review by visiting www.HarrisonburgVA.gov/parks-plan.

The community is encouraged to share ideas and current uses of park facilities. A survey has also been posted online for Parks and Recreation to collect this input.

It is anticipated that the 2013 Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan will be complete by the end of June.
