Construction of Signals Continues Along Virginia Avenue

Harrisonburg, VA – The City of Harrisonburg is wrapping up construction on Third Street this week and will continue with this project on Virginia Avenue next week.

Throughout next week, June 3-June 7, crews will continue installing pedestrian signals in the area of Virginia Avenue and Third Street.

Third Street will reopen and lanes on Virginia Avenue, north of this intersection, will be closed as the project is completed.

This signal work, along with the rest of the sidewalks that are being installed along Virginia Avenue, is part of the Safe Routes to School project.

Motorists are encouraged to avoid this particular intersection and pedestrians are asked to be vigilant when walking through this area.

This schedule could change due to inclement weather.
