Temporary Downtown Lane Closure

Harrisonburg, VA – Work continues on the downtown streetscape project and will continue to require lane closures in downtown Harrisonburg for the week of November 17 - 21.

The City of Harrisonburg, in partnership with Faulconer Construction, is making progress with Phase 2 of the Harrisonburg Streetscape Project.

- **Bruce Street**, from Main Street to slightly east of the intersection, will remain closed;
- **Water Street**, from Main Street to just east of the intersection will be closed; and
- The **right lane of Main Street** from Bruce Street to E. Market St. will be closed.

Contractors will install a pole foundation in front of Jess's. In addition, they plan to set the poles and mast arms for the signals at Bruce St. and Water St. this week as well as continue working on the concrete subslab for the intersections that remain.

This is subject to change due to weather conditions or if project circumstances warrant.

Access to the parking lots on Water Street will remain open. The parking lot in the rear of the Hardesty-Higgins House will remain open and accessible from Franklin Street. Signs have been placed to assist in directing visitors to this public parking lot.

Please slow down and drive cautiously in this work zone. The area will be well marked with signs to alert motorists. The City apologizes for any inconvenience this work may create and thanks everyone for their patience and cooperation.

Streetscape construction is still on track to be completed by December 2014 and the public is reminded that the businesses behind the construction barriers are still open and accessible!
