Maintenance Work Rescheduled - Impacts City Intersection

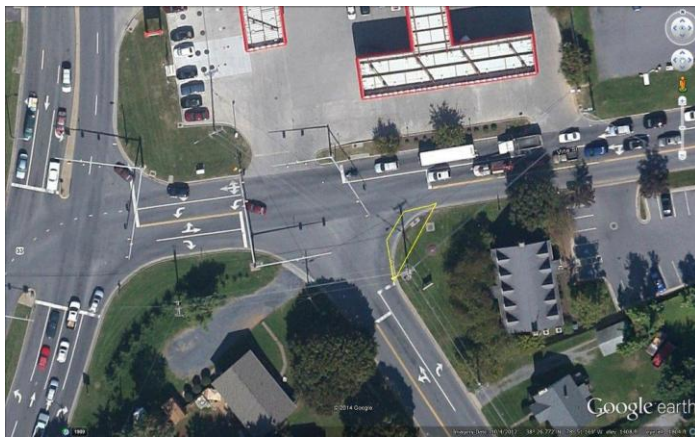
Harrisonburg, VA – Due to the weather the last couple of weeks, city crews have not been able to start the work at Country Club Road and Vine Street originally planned for earlier in the month. Maintenance crews will be replacing a drop inlet and curb and gutter at busy city intersection next week.

Now schedule for December 15-31, city public works' crews will perform work at Country Club Road and Vine Street to replace an inlet and surrounding curb and gutter. During that time, the turn radius will be reduced making it difficult for trucks on Country Club Road to make the turn onto Vine Street.

Public Works recommends truck traffic to use alternate routes.

Please slow down and drive cautiously in this work zone. The area will be well marked with signs to alert motorists. The City apologizes for any inconvenience this work may create and thanks everyone for their patience and cooperation.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions and unforeseen circumstances.
