Lee-Jackson and MLK, Jr. Holidays Alter City Schedules

Harrisonburg, VA – City offices in Harrisonburg will be closed on January 16 in observance of Lee-Jackson Day and January 19 in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

The Harrisonburg Department of Public Transportation (HDPT) will continue to provide regular bus service.

All city offices will reopen on Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at 8:00 a.m.

Trash and Recycling Collection

Please take note of the following trash, recycling, and bulk collection changes:

- Trash for Friday, January 16 will be collected on Thursday, January 15. Please hold Friday recycling until the next collection date of January 23.
- Trash for Monday, January 19 will be collected on Tuesday, January 20. Please hold Monday recycling until the next collection date of January 26

The city offers a service to residents, who wish to receive an extra reminder about the changes in their trash collection schedule. Residents may sign up for an email notification to be sent to them when there is a change in their trash collection. This typically occurs during the city holidays or when inclement weather affects the trash and recycling collection.
