City Hosts Bicycle and Pedestrian Workshop

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city is hosting a workshop that is free and open to the public.

On Tuesday, **May 19**, city staff along with the bicycle and pedestrian subcommittee will host a public workshop to kick off an update to Harrisonburg's bicycle and pedestrian plan. The workshop will be held at Thomas Harrison Middle School, 1311 W. Market St. from **6 p.m. until 8 p.m.** and participants are asked to arrive at the beginning of the event.

Community members are encouraged to attend and share thoughts on how to make walking and biking in Harrisonburg safer, more comfortable and more efficient.

The city has worked to provide a framework for enhancing the safety and attractiveness of walking and biking through various improvement projects and public programs. In 2010, Harrisonburg adopted its last bicycle and pedestrian plan, which is available at www.HarrisonburgVA.gov/bicycle-pedestrian-plan.

It is anticipated that the revised plan will be adopted in 2016.
