## Memorial Day Holiday Schedule

Harrisonburg, VA – City offices in Harrisonburg will be closed on Monday, May 25 in honor of the Memorial Day holiday.

### HOLIDAY TRASH SCHEDULE

Trash that is normally collected on Monday, May 25 will be collected on Tuesday, May 26. Residents who will be impacted by this are also asked to hold their recycling until the next collection date of June 1.

The city offers a service to residents, who wish to receive an extra reminder about the changes in their trash collection schedule. Residents may sign up for an email notification to be sent to them when there is a change in their trash collection. This typically occurs during the city holidays or when inclement weather affects the trash and recycling collection.
