## City Schedules Altered for Upcoming Holiday

Harrisonburg, VA – City offices in Harrisonburg will be closed on Friday, July 3 in honor of Independence Day.

### HOLIDAY TRASH SCHEDULE

Trash that is normally collected on Friday, July 3 will be collected on Thursday, July 2. Residents who will be impacted by this are also asked to hold their recycling until the next collection date of July 10.

The city offers a service to residents, who wish to receive an extra reminder about the changes in their trash collection schedule. Residents may sign up for an email notification to be sent to them when there is a change in their trash collection. This typically occurs during the city holidays or when inclement weather affects the trash and recycling collection.
