Safe Routes to School Project Nears Completion

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg is proud to announce the third Safe Routes to School Project at Stone Spring Elementary School is almost complete.

Friday, August 14 is the anticipated completion date for the project that began in May.

Construction along Peach Grove Avenue took place throughout the summer to install new sidewalks, a new traffic and pedestrian signal at the school entrance and sidewalk improvements on the school grounds.

In an effort to improve pedestrian and bicycle safety in neighborhoods surrounding the school, this project was awarded grant funding from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT).

The two previous Safe Routes to School Projects were completed in neighborhoods around Waterman Elementary School and Keister Elementary School.
