## City Seeks Volunteers at City Hall

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg is looking to the community to recruit volunteers in City Hall.

The week of September 7, city staff will be packing up boxes and moving into their new home, City Hall.

City Hall will have an information desk located on the main floor of the building, where a volunteer will have the opportunity to greet visitors and point them in the right direction or provide helpful information.

The city is seeking individuals, interested in serving as a volunteer to participate in this new program.

Volunteers serving at the front desk, would operate from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays recognized by the city. Each volunteer will work four and a half hour shifts at least once per week and be asked to commit to at least one year of service.

This program will give members of the community an opportunity to get involved and gain insight into their local government, while helping others.
