## Holiday Schedule for City Services

Harrisonburg, Va. – Harrisonburg city offices will be closed on Monday, September 7 in observance of Labor Day.

Trash that is regularly collected on Monday, September 7 will be collected on Tuesday, September 8.

Businesses and residents that receive private trash collection and are not impacted by the Single Stream Collection program are asked to hold their recycling collection until the next scheduled collection date.

The city offers a service to residents, who wish to receive an extra reminder about the changes in their trash collection schedule. Residents may sign up for an email notification to be sent to them when there is a change in their trash collection. This typically occurs during the city holidays or when inclement weather affects the trash and recycling collection.
