Upcoming Street Closure near City Hall

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg will soon close a street in order to complete the final phase of the construction of City Hall.

Starting Thursday, September 24, Warren Street will be closed to allow for the former council chambers and Planning and Community Development building to be demolished.

Warren Street runs from South Main to Liberty streets and to the south of the building being demolished.

The demolition of this building, in addition to the finished site work, will be the final steps in the construction of City Hall.

It is anticipated that this work will be completed by the middle to end of November.
