City Names Next Building Official

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg has named its next building official.

Ron Schuett has been named the city’s building official after serving as the acting building official since May 1 of this year. He was selected from a pool of more than 30 applicants.

“Ron brings outstanding qualifications to the position and we are confident in the leadership and direction he will provide not only to the department but also our community partners,” said Adam Fletcher, acting director of Planning and Community Development.

As the building official, Mr. Schuett supervises the department’s Building Inspections Division, which enforces the laws, ordinances, and codes related to construction and alteration of buildings within the city.

Mr. Schuett was hired to work for the city in 2013 as a deputy building official in the same department and has more than 20 years of work experience in construction and the code enforcement field.

The Department of Planning and Community Development is home to 25 employees and is divided into three divisions: building inspections, engineering, and planning and zoning.
