City Plans to Repair Valve

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city’s Public Utilities Department will soon begin work to repair a valve along Main Street.

On Tuesday, December 29 crews will begin work to repair a valve at the intersection of South Main Street and Bluestone Drive.

The function of a valve is to shut off the flow of water in a main when needed. Crews have identified a valve that is leaking and will make the necessary repairs. When a leaking valve is located in pavement, it is easily detected due to a wet spot that develops around the fitting.

Customers along South Main Street, from Maplehurst Avenue to Warsaw Avenue (as highlighted in the red box in the map below) may experience a temporary interruption in their water service on Tuesday.

Work will be taking place in the right hand, northbound lane of South Main Street at the intersection with Bluestone Drive. Northbound traffic on South Main Street will be reduced to one lane. Bluestone Drive will be closed at the intersection to traffic entering and exiting on to South Main Street.

It is anticipated that work will be completed by 3:30 p.m. on December 29.
