## Temporary Street Closure for Repair to Railroad

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city’s Public Works Department will temporarily close a street to allow for repair work to be completed on a section of railroad.

**Starting tomorrow, January 12, around 9:00 a.m., Mt. Clinton Pike, near the intersection of Virginia Avenue, where the railroad crosses the roadway, will be closed until tomorrow evening.**

A failure in the track was discovered by Norfolk Southern and it was determined that the repair was needed immediately.

The Public Works Department will close Mt. Clinton Pike, from Virginia Avenue to North Liberty Street to through traffic. Motorists needing to access businesses within this road closure will still be able to do so but traffic will not be permitted over the railroad tracks.
