City Dog License Fees Are Soon Due

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg reminds dog owners of the upcoming deadline to pay for dog licenses.

January 31 is the deadline for residents to pay this fee.

Individuals owning a dog within the city are required to obtain a dog license for each dog they own, pursuant to applicable state law and city code [Section 15-2-8](#).

The owner of the animal is responsible for presenting a valid rabies certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian for each dog.

To obtain a dog license, residents can visit the City Treasurer’s Office at 409 S. Main Street, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Licenses can also be obtained at the Harrisonburg-Rockingham SPCA, 2170 Old Furnace Road. To view a list of hours at the SPCA, visit www.rhspca.org.
