Reservoir Street Project Moves Forward

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city's Public Works Department will move forward with the next steps of the Reservoir Street improvement project.

Three bids were received at the end of January and the contract has been awarded to A&J Development and Excavating, Inc. of Mount Crawford.

The \$10,139,986.49 bid award amount is for the cost of construction. Construction is anticipated to begin in the middle of March or beginning of April, depending upon the weather.

Reservoir Street serves as an important link connecting Rockingham County and the southern end of the city with James Madison University and downtown Harrisonburg. It is located in a rapidly growing part of the region with numerous developments and future construction projects with additional housing. Reservoir Street also serves as a primary route to the local hospital.

This project will widen Reservoir Street from the city limits to University Boulevard and is expected to be completed by December 2017.
