New Restaurant Coming to Golf Course

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city’s Department of Parks and Recreation announces a new restaurant will be opening at Heritage Oaks Golf Course in the near future.

This week, a notice of award was issued to Triple B Café to operate food and beverage services out of the golf course.

Earlier this year, the city sought proposals for the restaurant, which offers a full kitchen and dining area to serve golfers, tournaments, special events, and the general public. Inside there is seating capacity of 42 with an additional 20 seats on the outdoor patio, which has beautiful mountain views and overlooks the practice putting green.

Three proposals were received and after careful consideration, Triple B Café was selected after meeting all of the elements the selection committee was looking for.

“We are excited for the café to be operating out of the restaurant at the golf course,” explained David Wigginton, assistant director of Parks and Recreation. “This is an ideal fit and we want to remind the public that this restaurant will be open for everyone, not just golfers!”

The menu will provide breakfast options along with salads, sandwiches, subs, a variety of sides, and drinks.

Triple B Café currently caters a variety of events and already serves Harrisonburg-based businesses, which the owners plan to continue.

It is anticipated that the restaurant will open in mid-April, just in time for the start of the most popular golfing seasons.
