## Real Estate Taxes are Due

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg reminds property owners that real estate taxes are due.

The due date for the second half of city real estate taxes is Sunday, June 5. Since the deadline falls on a Sunday, payments received on or postmarked by **Monday, June 6** will be considered timely.

Real estate taxes are calculated on a fiscal year basis and are billed twice a year.

The tax rate for the current fiscal year (July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016) is \$.72 cents per hundred of assessed value. This rate is set by Harrisonburg City Council and decided upon each year when the budget for the next fiscal year is approved.
