City Reminds Residents Fireworks are Not Permitted

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Fire Department (HFD) reminds residents that fireworks in the city are not allowed.

According to the Harrisonburg City Code Section 16-6-57, the sale, use, or possession of fireworks in the city of Harrisonburg is illegal. The safest way to enjoy fireworks is to attend the [Valley Fourth](#) celebrations in downtown Harrisonburg.

On July 4, members of HFD will be enforcing this code throughout the day and night.

“We want to keep the community safe, while also reminding the public that fireworks are not permitted,” explained Captain Mike Armstrong, deputy fire marshal.
