Downtown Street Closures & Parking Restrictions for Shenandoah Valley Pride Festival

HARRISONBURG, VA – July 21, 2016 – The Shenandoah Valley Pride Festival that is organized by the Shenandoah Valley Pride Alliance will return to Downtown Harrisonburg on Saturday, July 23, 2016, from 2 – 8 p.m. This special event will impact traffic and parking at Court Square. Please be aware of the following street closures and parking information.

10 a.m. – 9 p.m. Street Closures

- Court Square will be closed to vehicle traffic.
- W. Market Street from Court Square to the parking lot at N. Liberty and W. Market Street will be closed.
- The east half of Graham Street will be closed from Court Square to the parking lot in front of Clark & Bradshaw.

Parking:

- Signs will be posted prohibiting parking around Court Square from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday, July 23. Vehicles parked in this area after 8 a.m. will be towed.
- Free parking is located in other areas throughout downtown, and labeled with blue & gold signs; in addition to all other on-street parking and municipal lots, the Water and Elizabeth Street parking decks will be open.

Reopening Streets:

- Court Square, West Market Street, and Graham Street will reopen tentatively at 9 p.m., depending on crowd levels and is at the discretion of the Harrisonburg Police Department and Public Works.

No other streets and parking will be impacted by this event and major traffic circulation disruptions are not anticipated. This notice is intended to encourage people to plan alternate driving routes to their downtown destinations and preferred parking locations. Visitors and shoppers are encouraged to come downtown and enjoy this festival along with downtown shops, restaurants, and attractions that will all be open for business during regular hours of operation.
