Former Fire Chief Recognized for Service

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg’s former fire chief continues to receive recognition for his career with the Harrisonburg Fire Department (HFD).

Larry Shifflett was recognized by the International Association of Fire Chiefs in San Antonio, Texas.

He received the Alan Brunacini Fire Service Executive Safety Award for always being on the cutting edge of the fire service, implementing policies and procedures that dramatically enhanced the operation of the department while maintaining the highest level of safety for all personnel.
