Downtown Paving to Take Place

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city's Public Works Department will continue its annual paving program and begin work downtown this week.

On Thursday, August 25 and Friday, August 26, milling and paving operations will take place on South Main Street, from Grattan to Franklin streets.

Crews will mill and repave one lane of travel on Thursday and move to the other lane of travel on Friday. All work will be done during the daytime hours. Traffic will limited to one travel lane through the duration of this operation.

Every year, Public Works oversees this maintenance project, which resurfaces prioritized city streets based on the condition of the asphalt.

Motorists are reminded to slow down and use caution when traveling around crews working along the roadway, especially in the downtown area.
