## Downtown Paving to Take Place Starting Tomorrow

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city’s Public Works Department will continue its annual paving program and begin work downtown this week.

On **Friday, August 26 and Monday, August 29** milling and paving operations will take place on South Main Street, from Grattan to Franklin streets.

Crews will mill and repave one lane of travel on Friday and move to the other lane of travel on Monday. All work will be done during the daytime hours. Traffic will limited to one travel lane through the duration of this operation. On Friday afternoon, all travel lanes will reopen throughout the weekend until work begins on Monday.

Every year, Public Works oversees this maintenance project, which resurfaces prioritized city streets based on the condition of the asphalt.

Motorists are reminded to slow down and use caution when traveling around crews working along the roadway, especially in the downtown area.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen maintenance on equipment.
