Permit Now Available Online

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg reminds residents of the requirement to apply for a permit for a mass outdoor social gathering.

Any resident hosting a mass outdoor social gathering with 100 people or more that will also be using sound amplifying equipment must apply for a permit through the City Manager’s office. Applications for a permit shall be filed at least 15 days prior to the event.

The city’s noise ordinance was also updated to allow for enforcement of parties that are outside with 10 or more people during the daytime and nighttime hours.

It is still good practice to register smaller social gatherings through the non-emergency number at 540-434-4436. If complaints are received, the registrant will receive one warning and any additional complaints will result in officers responding to the location.
