## Overnight Lane Closures along Reservoir Street

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city’s Public Works Department continues managing the Reservoir Street improvement project.

On Sunday, October 16 from 7:00 p.m. until 3:00 a.m. the project’s general contractor will be working at the intersection of University Boulevard and Reservoir Street.

The remaining signal mast arms will be installed and during that process the intersection will be temporarily closed to traffic. Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes while this nighttime work is taking place and use caution when driving in this area.

Next week, crews will also work to install a sidewalk on Neff Avenue, from Reservoir Street to Medical Avenue. On the opposite side of Reservoir Street, on Neff Avenue going westbound, the curb, sidewalks, and storm sewer infrastructure will be installed. At various times next week, portions of Neff Avenue may be closed.

Throughout the duration of this project, motorists and pedestrians are reminded of the frequent changes in traffic patterns due to the ongoing construction. Motorists are also encouraged to drive slow and be mindful of the crews working close to the roadways.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen maintenance on equipment.
