Holiday Schedule for City Services

Harrisonburg, Va. – City offices will be closed on Monday, January 2 for the New Year’s Day holiday.

Household waste that is regularly collected on Monday, January 2 will be collected one day later on Tuesday, January 3.

Neighborhoods and businesses that receive private trash collection on Monday should hold their recycling until the next scheduled collection date.

Residents are also reminded that the annual collection of live Christmas trees will begin January 3 and run through January 6. Trees are to be placed at the curb for collection and after January 6, residents may place the tree out for collection on their regularly scheduled yard debris and bulk collection day. Artificial trees will not be collected.
