City’s Price Rotary Senior Center Closed for Renovations

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city’s Parks and Recreation Department is closing one of its facilities for extensive renovations.

The Price Rotary Senior Center, located in Westover Park behind the Community Activities Center, will be closed for several months while the facility is renovated.

This center hosts many of the city’s 50 and Wiser programs. Most of the daytime activities have been moved to the Simms Center, 620 Simms Avenue. Evening classes will continue to meet at the Community Activities Center.

The Valley Program for Aging Services (VPAS) Monday Senior program and the Meals on Wheels program has moved to the Harrisonburg First Church of the Brethren, 315 S. Dogwood Drive.

It is anticipated that the Price Rotary Senior Center will re-open later this year.
