Harrisonburg, Va. – Members of the public are invited to address a representative on Harrisonburg’s City Council at upcoming conversations.

Council Member Chris Jones will be hosting “community conversations” on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month during the lunch hour, from 12:00 p.m. until 1:00 p.m. These conversations will coincide with the regularly scheduled City Council meetings and will be held in council chambers, 409 S. Main St.

“I want to provide individuals with an opportunity to speak to one or more members of council,” explained Council Member Chris Jones. “It is my hope that city residents or business owners would converse with us on new ideas they have, concerns, or to ask questions about city projects.”

Matters discussed during these conversations will be brought to the attention of all council members during the regularly scheduled council meeting later that same evening.

“This will be an additional chance for community members to voice their thoughts and opinions, especially if they are unable to attend our regularly scheduled meetings,” explained Council Member Chris Jones.
