City Works to Repair Water Line Along Route 33

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg’s Public Utilities Department is working to repair a water line along Rawley Pike (Route 33 west).

A small leak in a 12 inch water line was discovered last week.

The work is being done in the area of Rawley Pike and Bear Wallow Lane and is expected to continue into the evening hours.

Residential customers should not be impacted by this repair; however, motorists traveling this roadway may experience delays.

It is likely that Rawley Pike will be narrowed to one lane as crews work to repair the water line. Motorists are encouraged to use caution and drive slow in this area.
