Temporary Street Closure for Utility Work

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg’s Public Utilities Department will conduct work overnight, which will cause a temporary street closure.

The northbound lanes of Main Street, from Grace Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Way, will be closed from Thursday, July 27 at 8:00 p.m. until Friday, July 28 at 6:00 a.m. A detour will be set up and clearly marked with signage.

Crews will work to remove old utility services in the 700 block of South Main Street, which is part of the Hotel Madison and Shenandoah Valley Conference Center project.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen maintenance on equipment.
