HRECC Receives Results from Accreditation Assessment

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg-Rockingham Emergency Communications Center (HRECC) has received its results from the team of assessors from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA).

This team of professionals arrived at the end of July to examine all aspects of the HRECC’s policies and procedures, management, operations, and support services. An on-site assessment and re-accreditation happens every three years for the CALEA assessors to ensure the HRECC is continuing to meet the standards and maintain their accreditation.

HRECC was recently notified that they received a perfect on-site assessment from the CALEA assessors. Since receiving its accreditation in 2011, this is the first time HRECC completed the assessment with no areas for suggested improvement and no exceptions to standards.

“I am extremely proud of the staff members at HRECC to receive these results from the assessment,” explained Jim Junkins, director of HRECC. “This continues to prove their dedication and commitment to excellence in their workplace.”

In November, HRECC will go before the CALEA Commission to receive the final decision on the re-accreditation for this cycle.
