Refuse and recycling that is normally collected on Monday, January 1 will be collected on Tuesday, January 2.

Annual Tree Collection

Residents are also reminded of the annual collection of live Christmas trees. From January 2 through January 5, residents are asked to place their live, undecorated trees at the curb for crews with the Public Works Department to collect. Please don’t forget to remove all lights and ornaments from the tree too!

After January 5, the live trees may be placed by the curb for their regularly scheduled bulk and yard debris collection. Artificial trees will not be collected as part of the annual curbside tree collection.
