## Temporary Interruption in Water Service

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg’s Public Utilities Department will be conducting work this week that will cause a temporary interruption in water service.

On Thursday, February 1 from approximately 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., field utility crews will conduct work on West Water Street, from South Brooke Avenue to High Street.

Crews will shut down the water line in this area to repair an existing water line that services a home along Water Street.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen maintenance on equipment.
