## HFD Notifies Residents of a Smoke Alarm Recall

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Fire Department (HFD) encourages residents, property owners, and business owners to check all smoke alarms within your home or business.

The United States Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) issued a notice that Kidde has recalled the dual sensor smoke alarms due to risk of failure to alert consumers to a fire. This recall is for models PI2010 and PI9010.

If you do have these recalled smoke alarms, they will need to be replaced.
