City Opens Survey for Input on Next Police Chief

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg, in partnership with The Novak Consulting Group, has opened a survey to collect input from the community on the police chief position.

The Novak Consulting Group was selected by a committee, led by the city manager, to begin the recruitment process for the city’s next police chief.

The next step in this process is to hear from the community through a survey, which is open to the public.

“We are eager to hear from our residents and learn what they value in a leader of the police department,” explained City Manager Eric Campbell. “This information will help the consultant compile a profile for the next chief of police.”
