Courts Temporarily Closed for Resurfacing

Harrisonburg, Va. – Harrisonburg Parks and Recreation will be conducting maintenance work at a city basketball court and tennis court.

Ralph Sampson Park basketball courts and Eastover tennis courts will be closed to the public for a court resurfacing project that begins this week.

All four courts will be closed for at least one week per court for the resurfacing project work to be completed. The expected time frame for all of the courts to be completed is four weeks.

Signs will be placed at the courts to advertise the closing, basketball nets will be removed discouraging play, and no lights will be turned on during the evening hours.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen maintenance on equipment.
