Portion of South High Street Closed Due to Traffic Crash

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) is on the scene of a serious traffic crash that occurred this morning, causing some traffic delays.

Around 10:30 a.m. today, there was a traffic crash involving a motorcycle and four-door sedan in the 1700 block of South High Street, near Pear Street.

Each vehicle was occupied with one person, both of which were transported to area hospitals. The driver of the motorcycle was airlifted with serious injuries.

Motorists are advised that both southbound lanes of South High Street are closed at this time and should take alternate routes. Alternate routes to avoid this location are South Avenue, Erickson Avenue, and Pear Street.

HPD’s accident reconstruction team is on scene to investigate the traffic crash.
