Street Closures for Work on Railroad Crossings

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg’s Public Works Department is providing assistance, while upgrades at some railroad crossings are being made.

Norfolk Southern will be making upgrades at three different railroad crossings.

- Harrison Street, near Warsaw Avenue

This intersection will be closed from Monday, July 23 at 11:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

- Maryland Avenue, between Central Avenue and Roosevelt Street

This intersection will be closed from Monday, July 23 at 11:00 a.m. until Tuesday, July 24 at 7:00 p.m.

- South Avenue, between Central Avenue and High Street

This intersection will be closed from Tuesday, July 24 at 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes and avoid the area of these three railroad crossings.

It is anticipated that all work should be complete by the evening of Tuesday, July 24.
