Westover Pool Closes for Resurfacing and Splash Pad Project

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Parks and Recreation Department will close Westover Pool for the season on Friday, August 24.

Pre-construction evaluation was being conducted for the resurfacing and splash pad project, which revealed additional work that needed to be conducted before the construction begins. The pool needed to be closed early, to allow the city to begin working on the unexpected repairs to avoid future delays in the overall renovation timeline.

The dog days dog swim that was to be held on Sunday, August 26 is being cancelled.

Staff asks for the public to stay tuned for updates as the pool resurfacing and splash pad installation takes place. The grand opening for the new splash pad is anticipated to take place next summer.
